BRUSH SITE MANAGEMENT

Zielsdorf asked the Council to consider staffing the brush site during the weekend and some weeknights. There have been a large number of non residents using the site which is greatly increasing the amount of brush in the site. Some hours will be staffed and the issue will be revisited.

PETERMAN STREET DRAINAGE ISSUES

Paul Peterman is requesting the City assist with the water pooling and draining on his property. Council asked to see plans and prices.

BLAIR WARNER SEWER LINE DISCUSSION

Staff was asked to review the costs of construction inflation as opposed to the CPI. They will return with additional information.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

Council discussed the budget with reference to the increased cost of seal coat and crack sealing.

PUBLIC SAFETY DOLLARS – LAW ENFORCEMENT CLASS

Council expressed their support for the program but would like to see if additional funding can be received from the townships and the City of Mazeppa, which are all in the school district.
