APPROVE AGENDA

MOTION SCHULTE second WICHMANN to approve the agenda. Carried unanimously.

APPROVE MINUTES

MOTION SCHULTE second WICHMANN to approve the minutes from August 3, 2020. Carried unanimously.

APPROVE ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

MOTION WICHMANN second SCHLUTE to approve the accounts payable in the amount of \$6,463.72. Carried unanimously.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

PRIORITY LIST - ICE RINK, CAMPGROUND UPGRADES, SHELTER BATHROOM, PARK ROAD

Olson stated that Schumacher Excavating will excavate the area for the ice rink when they are in the area. Raasch contacted Krause Masonry regarding the cement for the ice rink. They will lay it as soon as they have time (this fall or next year.) Olson stated that the MN Department of Health needs a drawing of the potential new campground layout. Raasch stated he has not heard back regarding some of the bids for the new park bathrooms yet.

EASEMENT REQUEST – 207 E 6TH ST

Tammy Gruhlke is requesting a 10-foot easement into East Park to build a garage in her back yard. The easement would be to accommodate a driveway to said garage. **MOTION WICHMANN** second **SCHULTE** to decline the request of selling Park Land. Carried unanimously.

NEW POOL DOOR

Olson asked the Park Board for permission to obtain quotes regarding a new entrance door at the pool. The current door is beginning to erode at the bottom. Olson estimated the cost around \$3,000. Horvath suggested finding an alternative option due to the possibility of a new pool in the near future.
