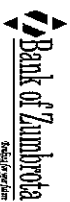

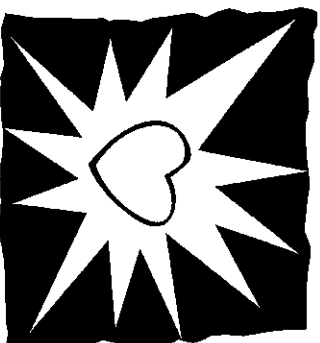

# Services Provided directly to clients

Volunteer **Transportation** rides are available to the following : doctors offices, dental offices, mental health offices, pharmacies, grocery stores, food shelves and Public Health offices.

Volunteer **Friendly Visiting** is available to people who are unable to leave their home for socialization, or a friendly check in.

Volunteer **Respite Care** is available to care givers who need time to rest or just time away, personal time for their own medical appointments or need to do other errands.

Volunteer **Library drop-off & pick-up** is provided to people who can not get to the library on a consistent basis.

Volunteer **Chore Services** is provided to people who are unable to complete the chore, such as vacuuming, dusting, and doing dishes, etc.

**FIACGC's mission:** To serve people of all ages, with identified needs, through casual care giving, education, and assistance to remain independent.

# Volunteer Opportunities

*Volunteer Opportunities, directly:*

**Transportation**—as often as there is a need and you are available.

**Friendly Visiting**—up to 4 hours a week with a care receiver.

**Respite Care**—up to 4 hours a week.

**Library drop-off & pick-up**—twice a month.

**Chore Service**—as needed.

# Who Qualifies & Service Area...

FIACGC provides all services to people 60 years of age and older

If you are disabled with low income and not 60 years of age and older you may qualify for friendly visiting, respite care, and chore services.

If you live in Goodhue County and are on Medical Assistance you qualify for transportation to your medical, dental, and mental health appointments.

## Service Area:

**WHO:** We serve the residents of the Zumbrota-Mazeppa school district, Goodhue-Bellechester school district, and the Kenyon-Wanamingo school district who meet our qualifications.

**WHERE:** For transportation our Volunteer drivers go to the Twin Cities, Blooming Prairie, Faribault, Red Wing, Rochester, Owatonna, and local areas.
