

ORDINANCE 22-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZUMBROTA CITY CODE CHAPTER 72, PARKING REGULATIONS

The Council of the City of Zumbrota does ordain that Section 72.02(B) of the Zumbrota City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 72.02 NO PARKING, STOPPING, OR STANDING

(B) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, no person shall stop or park a vehicle in an established no stopping or standing zone when stopping or standing is prohibited. No vehicle shall be parked in a no parking zone during hours when parking is prohibited, except that a vehicle may be parked temporarily in such a zone for the purpose of forming a funeral procession, and a truck may be parked temporarily for the purpose of loading or unloading where access to the premises is not otherwise available. No vehicle shall be parked within twenty feet of an intersection with another street, within ten feet of a fire hydrant, or at a place where temporary signs prohibit parking as long as such signs are in place. No vehicles shall be parked within 10 feet of any curbside mailbox or private driveway unless approved by property owner. (1982 Code, § 701.06) Penalty, see § 70.99 and § 10.99.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
